



CONCOURS 2025 RULES & REGULATIONS

Yorkshire Porsche Festival – Lotherton Hall – 10th August 2025

CONDITIONS ON THE DAY AND THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES MAY FORCE CHANGES TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. CHANGES AND QUERIES RELATING TO THESE REGULATIONS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE CONCOURS ADVISORY GROUP.

1. CONCOURS CLASSES

This competition is to encourage a competitive element to the presentation of the best Porsches that Porsche Club GB can offer, and members are encouraged to take part as part of the main Porsche display. Good preparation will endorse the best maintenance and aesthetics of Porsche cars and will be judged as presented in the following classes.

CLASSIC - Pre 1996
MODERN CLASSIC - 1996 to 2012
CONTEMPARY – 2013 to 2021

A final prize of car of the show will be chosen between the winners of each class.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 All competitors must be paid up members of PCGB. Entries must be made on the official page through the club website before Thursday 31st July 2025. Any entries received after this closing date will be considered at the discretion of the Concours Advisory Group, but may not be eligible for the main prize.
- 2.2 Entries will be restricted to Porsche manufactured vehicles only.
- 2.3 Each vehicle must have current MOT where appropriate and be in road worthy condition. A safety inspection will not be part of the judging process.
- 2.4 Each competitor will receive all necessary display and judging information prior to the event.
- 2.5 Each accepted entry must be registered at the PCGB Club tent by the advised time.
- 2.6 Minimum mileage allowed is 5000 miles. No vehicles less than 3 years old.
- 2.7 NO trailered cars are permitted to enter the event venue. All entries must be driven under their own power from the outer entry gate into the venue to be parked in the allocated Concours parking area.

3. SCORING: GENERAL

The judges will be briefed to focus on cleanliness, and overall condition of the vehicle. Cleanliness, referring to all scoring areas having received attention. Overall condition referring to the appearance of all scoring areas.

4. SCORING: SPECIFICS

Vehicles will be judged as an assembled unit. Parts such as wheels, bumpers, etc, must be attached to the car in the specified position and manner. Hoods/soft tops/targa roof panels must be raised or in place as the case may be.

4.1 Each vehicle will be marked out of the possible total points as indicated on the judges marking sheet, according to the following categories – Exterior, Interior, Luggage area, and Engine bay. Multiple judges will be used to provide a balanced view.

4.2 Extra points will be awarded for higher mileage in all classes, and age of vehicle in Contemporary category. This is to prevent a brand new or non-driven vehicle having an unfair advantage over a regularly driven car.

4.3 In the event of a points tie at the completion of judging, the winner will be at the discretion of the Concours Advisory Group.

Attention is drawn that each competitor should display on their vehicle a Porsche Club GB badge Club GB badge on the front windscreen. Failure to display one of these badges as indicated will result in 5 points being deducted from the overall final score.

5. JUDGING

5.1 On arrival, you will be shown to your parking area. You should then “sign on” at the appointed time. when you will be advised of your entry number. Competitors should clearly display their competition detail on the dashboard of their car.

5.2 Please follow the instructions provided and on the day. There is a very tight schedule for proceedings, so you must following the details and timings provided.

5.3 When judging commences, please ensure you are with your vehicle at all times. At the appointed time. It is necessary that you remain with your vehicle throughout the judging process.

5.4 Once judging commences no further preparation can be performed on your vehicle apart from light dusting.

5.5 The judging team will comprise of individuals selected for their broad knowledge of the Porsche marque, concours presentation, and who also have specialised knowledge to decide on certain points.

5.6 There will be one team of judges to ensure consistency of judging. The same amount of time will be allocated on each car.

5.7 Judging is a difficult job. Please do not talk to or distract the judges during their task.

6. AWARDS

An awards ceremony will take place following the completion of judging at the event.

There will be permanent trophies for the winners to keep for each of the classes, and these will be awarded at the event. Details may change and is at the discretion of the Concours Advisory Group.

The Judge's decision is final. Individual score sheets will be forwarded to each competitor after the event.

7 HEALTH AND SAFETY

Competitors are reminded that they should take precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of themselves and others. Vehicles will be parked on grass, so please avoid jacking cars up as this may be an unsafe surface.

Competitors should ensure that harmful substances are properly contained and wear any necessary PPE when handling these substances. The Concours area is a strictly non-smoking area due to the fact that competitors may be using substances that contain flammable materials. Trip hazards should be avoided. The Concours area must be kept clear during preparation time with the exception of the Concours Coordinator, the competitors, the Concours judges and other appointed officials such as marshals in order to avoid a member of the public being hurt. Members of the public may be in the preparation area during preparation time.

For their own safety whilst a car is jacked up and/or on axle stands, any person or persons accompanying Concours competitors (i.e. wives, children or friends) should cease assisting with the car preparation and leave the Concours area.

Any queries or matters arising regarding Health and Safety should be directed to the Health & Safety representative.

8 ENTRIES

Entries must be made via the event link for Yorkshire Porsche Festival link, and a separate ticket to the event **must** also be purchased to gain entry.

9 AMENDMENTS

Porsche Club GB and the organizing advisory group reserve the right to amend these rules and regulations at their discretion and without prior warning.

FINAL COMMENTS

Please at all times respect all other competitors, judges, marshalls, members and the general public, and treat everyone on site with the respect you would expect to receive yourself.

This is a beautiful venue for beautiful cars, and is organized to have fun and interest for members as well as providing competitive interest.
