



I know that many of you will have attended the recent RAF Benevolent Fund events at Broomhall House in 2018/2019 and will appreciate just how enjoyable and exclusive these events turned out to be.

The popularity of these two events, which were created raise funds for the Benevolent Fund gave us the foundations of creating a unique, relaxed and exciting annual car show for Scotland.

Broomhall House and the Bruce family have had links with many of the greats of motorsport for decades now and are keen to work with Driving Scotland to create a Scottish version of the Goodwood Festival of Speed.

The Scottish Torque Show will be held in the grounds of Broomhall House near Limekilns in Fife on Sunday 20th September 2020 between 10am and 5pm

A proportion of all monies raised on the day will again be donated to our wonderful RAF Benevolent Fund, who are doing a great deal of work to support this show for 2020

2020 is such a significant year for the RAF as they commemorate 80 years since the 'Battle of Britain' and they are certainly going to put on a great show for us on the day.

This event at Broomhall House will possibly be the ONLY event in 2020 in Scotland where we will have our own, exclusive 'Air show'

This event will be exclusive to everyone who wants to come along and display their car or motorcycle etc. on the day and will not be open to the general public.

Display areas for various Marques and Clubs will be allocated in the grounds of Broomhall House, where, after your arrival you can then relax, set up your chairs and enjoy the unique and exciting day of events and displays that will be provided for you.

The line-up for the inaugural Scottish Torque Show will be:

- Walk around the grounds of the ancestral home of the Bruce family and have uninterrupted access to look around the static displays and cars on show.
- Centre pieces on display will be a Supermarine Spitfire with an assortment of historic WW2 era army and air force vehicles and machinery - commemorating 80 Years since the 'Battle of Britain'
- Also, an opportunity to have a professional photograph taken with the Spitfire, whilst wearing an **AUTHENTIC WW2 Spitfire pilots flying jacket and helmet**.
- A private 'Air show' (weather permitting) will be put on throughout the day with various aircraft performing a fly past for us both in the morning and afternoon.

- The 'MacAndrew Sisters' Scotland's Premier Vintage Vocal Harmony Group will be performing several times throughout the day singing some of the iconic 1940's songs from the WW2 era
- RAF police dog displays and the opportunity to perhaps get involved with one or two of their exercises if you are brave enough!
- If guidelines allow, then some private tours, hosted by Lord Bruce himself will be available to see part of the history within Broomhall House
- Artisan food vendors will on site all day selling top quality hot food and coffee and tea
- Flight simulators to test your 'Top Gun' skills
- The Pipes and Drums of the RAF Regiment Band will be playing during the day
- Show will close with a fly past of a Spitfire based in Scotland

The admission cost for this exclusive event is only £25 per car, including driver and only £10 thereafter for any passenger over 16 years of age.

This represents fantastic value to be a part of this exclusive event which will in essence be a grand garden party, car show and air show, as well as top class musical entertainment and static displays.

As mentioned before, a proportion of all monies raised on the day will be donated to the RAF Benevolent Fund to allow them to continue in support of our RAF veterans and serving members.

Participants are encouraged to wear costume that fits with the era of the 1940's or indeed that compliments the vehicles you bring to the show.

There will be a trophy awarded at the end of the show by Lord Bruce to the vehicle/occupants that he feels best reflects the spirit of the event and the day.

This invitation is extended to all car clubs, who will be allocated their own private display areas.
