

DUXFORD DIRECTIONS

Duxford Airfield, Gate 1, CB22 4QR

1. **Please arrive between 9.30am and 11.30am**, after which the gate will close. We have our own 'Porsche only' entrance at GATE 1. This is 200 yards along from the main public entrance. Except for marshals and display cars, you will not be allowed onto the site before 9.30a.m.
2. Duxford say no crossing the carriageway of A505 will be allowed. This means cars approaching from the west (Royston direction) must go up to the roundabout at junction 10 of the M11 and come back travelling west. Similarly, there is to be no going across the A505 when departing, so all cars must turn **LEFT**.
3. **Windscreen Swing tickets for Boxster Register parking must be clearly displayed at entry.** Apart from those in Boxster Register parking, there will be no other Register or Region parking.
4. **Please print your tickets off and have your tickets for the driver and all passengers ready to be shown to the marshals upon entry.**
5. If any person in a car does not have a ticket, they will be refused entry. There is no facility to buy tickets on the day, and that includes passengers.
6. The parking area will be for Porsche cars only and we are expecting over 700 vehicles.
7. There will be 100 Boxsters celebrating their 25th anniversary and we will also have a display of Porsche through the years, with models from the 356 to the Taycan in celebration of the Club's 60th anniversary.
8. Porsche Centres Cambridge and Colchester will have a display of cars, Porsche merchandising, and representatives present to answer queries, e.g., regarding Porsche Classic. They will also run a raffle on behalf of Essex & Herts Air Ambulance which, it is hoped, you will be generous with your support, the main prize being a Porsche Driving Experience at Silverstone Porsche Driving Experience Centre accompanied by a Porsche driving Consultant.
9. Please be respectful to the marshals and park where requested – we have limited time and space to park cars, so getting cars parked quickly and in the right place will be paramount, although we have allowed ample space for opening car doors.
10. No animals, e.g., dogs, or drones, are allowed on-site.
11. Duxford request no excessive engine noise whilst arriving and departing, or on-site, and there is a 5 mph limit on-site.
12. We expect coffee/tea and burger vans to be present on our site, but there are also ample refreshment facilities in the museum, or you are welcome to bring your own picnics if you prefer.
13. Please take **ALL** litter home with you to leave the site tidy.
14. Depending upon COVID rules at the time, and Museum requirements, face coverings may be required.
