

ITINERARY FOR TRIP TO DINSLAKEN SHOW

Monday 29th April - Travel to Hull P&O Ferry Port for the early evening crossing over to Rotterdam. Ferry departs at 8.30pm with boarding closing 90 minutes beforehand. Ideally, we get there for about 4.30pm to get boarded early and settled in.

Tuesday 30th April – Ferry arrives at 8.30am then we travel from Rotterdam to Oberhausen and check into the TRYP Hotel **(150 miles)**

Wednesday 1st May - Travel to Dinslaken for the Porsche Festival **(12 miles each way)**
After the show return to the hotel and enjoy a relaxing evening where you are free to explore and enjoy the restaurants and bars close by.

Thursday 2nd May - Travel back to Rotterdam for the evening ferry back to Hull for those who wish to do so departing at 8.00pm **(150 miles)**

Friday 3rd May - Head off home from Hull Ferry Port. The ferry usually docks around 8.00am

EXTENDED TRIP OPTION FOR THOSE WANTING A LONGER TRIP

For those who would like to do a bit more, why not extend your European adventure and join some of us who are planning to continue to Nurburgring then to Spa Francorchamps Circuit. Why not try a lap of the iconic circuit, visit the museum or just chill out in your circuit view room and watch the action, or if you prefer visit some of the beautiful villages or small towns nearby.

Distance from Oberhausen to Nurburgring (110 miles)

Distance from Nurburgring to Spa (67 miles)

Distance from Spa back to Rotterdam Europort (182 miles)

Opening times for the Nordschleife in 2019 have not been released yet but will hopefully be announced in early 2019

Thursday 2nd May - Travel to Nurburgring with hopefully the opportunity to go round the circuit and then stay overnight. Evening meal in the iconic Pistenklause Restaurant (owned by the family of Sabine Schmidt – Racing Driver)

Friday 3rd May - After Breakfast we take to the road for the relatively short 55 mile drive to the Spa Francorchamps circuit. Friday is practice day for the FIA WEC 6 Hours of Spa with the race on Saturday, alternatively if you prefer there are lots of places to visit on route or nearby.

Saturday 4th May - Watch the FIA WEC 6 hours of Spa race then stay overnight at our hotel 20 minutes away from Spa Circuit.

Sunday 5th May – A leisurely drive back to Rotterdam for the overnight Ferry departing at 8.00pm.

Monday 6th May – Ferry arrives in Hull at 8.00am then travel home **(This day is a Bank Holiday in the UK)**

APPROXIMATE COSTS (Based on 2 people sharing rooms/cabins)

Return Ferry from Hull to Rotterdam with 1 Car and a Premier Outside Cabin : £260 per person (add approx. £90 total for 2nd car) including upgrade Brasserie breakfast and evening meal. If you do not want the meals included, then the price is £190 per person with the same cabin and 1 car saving £70

Porsche Festival Tickets : €15 per car
