Sunday 24 April 2016
Scenic Drive and Barbeque

For this year's Spring Drive, we start at Exeter Services. Departing at 1000 we head off across Dartmoor, via Moretonhampstead, to our first stop at The Two Bridges Hotel for a coffee/tea stop. There will be a number of points along the route where you can join in the drive if you don't fancy starting at Exeter.

Leaving Two Bridges we continue across the moor and descend into the historic Stannary town of Tavistock. **Departing** Tavistock on the A390 we drop down into the Tamar valley and cross the river into Cornwall at Gunnislake (check passports!)

Climbing back up the west side of the Tamar valley we catch some distant views to the left down to the coast and Plymouth Sound. From here we head N/NW to Launceston on some lovely driving roads. After a short squirt down the A30 we then head off across open moorland, passing the large wind farm on the A395, to join the A39 near Davidstow with views of Bodmin Moor.

After another short burst on the A road we turn off to Slaughter Bridge, pass the Arthurian Centre and follow the B3314 down to Higher Penmayne Farm.

At Higher Penmayne will we be hosted by member Roger Cole who will be cooking up a BBQ!

Light **liquid** refreshments will be provided so if you want anything stronger best bring your own! There should be plenty of seating but again, if you have a favourite folding chair, please bring it. There will be £10 per head charge for the food and light refreshments and please let us know if you have any dietary requirements.

A route map and directions will be made available to those taking part nearer the date.

1100	Arrive Two Bridges for coffee/tea – first joining point
1145	Depart Two Bridges
1200	Tavistock – second joining point
1220	Kelly Bray, north of Callington – third joining point
1250	Launceston – final joining point
1330	Arrive at Higher Penmayne Farm.
