Organised by the **Crash Box & Classic Car Club** (<http://crashboxclub.co.uk/>), this event, now thought to be the largest of its type in the South West, is organised solely by a dedicated Rally Team.

Each year they attract well over 1,000 individual entries from owners of Classic Cars & Motorcycles. In addition a vast number of vintage tractors, commercial vehicles and traction engines will be on display. A good part of the Show field is covered by a large Exhibitors area - auto jumblers, trade stands, craft stalls, children's amusements and special displays. The Main Ring has a full timetable on both Saturday and Sunday with displays from each of the various classes.

As in 2022, the Region will be holding its **Annual Concours Event on the Saturday**, with those wishing to enter the Concours being **given priority on this day**. This year we will once again have a **show'n'shine class** – we have changed the rules such that you can enter this class as many times as you wish. The other classes will be Air-cooled, Water-cooled* Meister and Visitor.

To accommodate the Concours, we have a large stand, which will enable us to have plenty of room on the Saturday. Therefore on the Sunday, more members will be able to come along and show their cars. **There is a limit of 25 cars on the Club stand per day.**

All in all it's a great day out for all the family. Come and join us on the Porsche Club Stand.

Gates open at 8.30am with all entrants required in **place by 9.50am** and cleaning completed by **11.30am** for judging to start.
